We will have a Talent Chapel for Secondary students, and one for Elementary students.

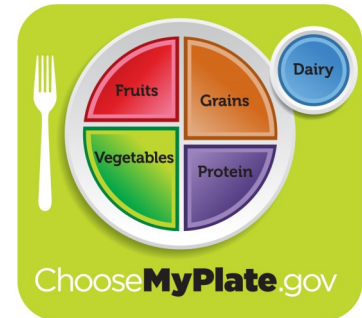
