○ Financial Aid and Scholarship

Seniors may begin filling out the FAFSA after October 1, 2017. The FAFSA federal deadline is June 30, 2019, although your college may have a different deadline. Students will need their parent's tax information in order to fill out the FAFSA. The FAFSA is required for the student to receive any federal aid (loans, grants, work study). ○ Senior Year Checklist At A Glance

FALL

- Visit colleges, either in person or online
- Start filling out college applications (many now use the Common Application).
- Study for and take the ACT/SAT if you haven't done so yet or if you want to improve your score.

WINTER

- Look for college scholarships online using Fastweb or other scholarship searches.
- Fill out the FAFSA (after January 1).
- Learn about college loan options with your parents.
- Finish applying to all potential colleges (this should be done before Christmas break).
- Retake the ACT/SAT if you want to improve your score.

SPRING

- With your parents, review financial aid packages of colleges at which you are accepted to see which college works best for your budget.
- Complete the required paperwork for enrollment at the college of your choice.
